A student who seeks admission at Bayan College needs to take placement test. College conducts placement test in English Language, Math and Computer to check the academic skill levels of entering students. Then the college places each student in classes at the right level based on their score.

A good number of students appeared in

the placement test which was held in two modules i.e. English Language Test for 2 hours duration and Math & Computer Test for 1.5 hrs. duration. The students said that it was really challenging.

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BC HOSTS ENGLISH SEMINAR




BAYAN: Dr. Heather Fielding, a visiting Associate Professor from Purdue University at the Department of English Studies, Bayan College, along with Dr. Lina Ibrahim HoD of Department of English Studies presented a paper titled Rokeya Hossain and Virginia Woolf Transnational Perspectives on Early 20th C. Feminist Writing.

The paper presented, highlighted the mutual features in the writings of both novelists. Even though years separate them and they come from different parts of the world, yet they share the concern for women education and the need to free women from the control of the patriarchal societies in which they lived. The presenters pointed out that the difference of faith, Rokeya is a Muslim and Virginia is a Christian didn't have any effect on their approach to the topic. They shared the idea that if women are kept in the dark the society will never achieve its goal in becoming fully developed. The presenters explained

how both writers insisted

on the need for educating women and allowing their participation in the public sphere and how faulty are the assumptions that women are physically and intellectually inferior to man. Given the chance women can achieve much more than anyone can imagine.




